



THE MANY WAYS TO PAY YOUR PLEDGE

Pledges can be paid in any of the following ways:

Check: Make your check payable to “St. Mark’s Church”. On the memo line write “pledge”.

- place a check in our Sunday collection plate, or mail it to
St. Mark’s Church, 301 A Street SE, Washington, DC 20003
- use your bank’s online services to automatically mail a check to St. Mark’s.

Cash: Enclose your donation in a sealed envelope noting your name plus some identifying information such as pledge number, e-mail address or phone number to help distinguish between similar names.

Envelopes are available in the Nave wall racks. Place your envelope in a Sunday collection plate or drop it in the locked “clergy/staff” drop box on the 2nd floor set into the wall just outside the church offices.

Credit/Debit Card: Visit www.stmarks.net and click on the *Donate* link at the top of the home page. The prompts will take you to our secure on-line site where you can use your bank account or your credit/debit card to pay your pledge in either a single payment or installments.

Text Message: To make a contribution from your phone, send a text to 73256 such as

- “**stmarks20003 pledge \$50**” to pay \$50 on your current year pledge.
 - “**stmarks20003 vision \$100**” to pay \$100 of your Extended Vision Capital Campaign pledge.
- The first time you send a text you will be prompted for your contact and payment information.

Automatic Debit from Your Checking Account: Fill out the “*Authorization for St. Mark’s Pledge Payment by Automatic Checking Account Withdrawals*” and return it to the church office. The form can be found by visiting www.stmarks.net and clicking on the *Donate* link at the top of the home page and then choosing *Forms*. A new form must be signed each year authorizing St. Mark’s to withdraw your pledge payments.

Payroll Deduction and/or Employer Match: If you would like to ask your employer to deduct pledge payments from your payroll or to match your donation, please contact our Finance Manager, Patricia, at 202-543-0053 x305. She can provide any information needed for your employer and obtain the information she needs from you to ensure acknowledgement of your payments.
